

# The International Vision Facilitation Committee's Mission – Vision – Philosophy

## Mission:

***“Organized, dedicated and trained Rotarians guiding a Rotary club to better envision its future.”***

## Vision Statements:

- We will create a foundation for a 5 year plan broken down into annual goals.
- We will broaden the make-up of our International Vision Committee and strive to constantly improve our delivery process and documented structure to remain relevant to the cultures and changing landscape of Rotary.
- We will guard the integrity of our program to maintain a consistent and predictable outcome for each of the clubs we serve with an International Vision Facilitation Committee established for the quality control of our programs.
- We will experience International saturation of opportunity for every District in Rotary to have a trained Club Vision Facilitation Team in its district.
- We will gain membership retention and growth through the consensus, consistency and continuity created from a Visioning Session.

## Philosophy Statements:

- We affirm the core values of Rotary within our presentations.
- We espouse Continuity, Consistency and Consensus within the Visioning Process.
- We promote the Club Visioning Process to improve membership growth and retention.
- We expose the club to the principles of the Club Leadership Plan.
- We support the development of the District Leadership Plan.
- We endorse a President's Development Committee as the strategic platform serving every club.
- We expose the average Rotarian to the greater world of Rotary.
- The end result in any visioning session is for the Rotary Club to commit to and be successful delivering Rotary Projects.
- Because the Club Vision Facilitation is NOT a strategic plan it does not include a SWOT analysis.
- The Vision Process is not simply a facilitation it shall include Rotary knowledge and training.
- We develop future leaders for Rotary Districts at all levels by...
  - Identifying future leaders at the club level.
  - Developing District leaders through their experience serving as facilitators.
- Our trained facilitators will develop personally and professionally, applying their trained facilitation skills in and out of Rotary.
- We are District Rotarian Facilitators who have gone through training and do not charge for our time when delivering a Club Vision session to District clubs.
- We will not serve a club unless invited.

## **Standards and Expectations:**

- The International Vision Facilitation Committee expects participating District Vision Facilitation Teams to adhere to the curriculum and Visioning Process.
- To ensure quality control, the curriculum should not be released or modified with those who have not been officially trained and certified.
- Participating districts are expected to share and report best practices and experiences to further enhance the process and curriculum.
- District Governors must commit to supporting and promoting the Club Vision Facilitation program within their district. They would be expected to ...
  - Identify and Recruit the District Vision Facilitation Committee Chair.
  - Commit to the recruitment and training of the District Facilitators.
  - Support the Chair via promoting the Vision Process & Team at every opportunity within the District.
  - DG must sign agreement and support subscription fee of \$100 per year payable to the International Visioning Committee to underwrite the technology platform that will support your District Vision Team.
- Individuals will be selected as facilitators and move up through the certification levels based on Rotary knowledge and facilitation skill development.
- All Rotary Facilitators donate their time and skills. Expense to a facilitated club is limited to facility cost, food and supplies of the facilitation.
- Club vision event reimbursement for usual and out of pocket expenses (for example, mileage) will be defined by each district.
